Dear Restore Families,

As Restore’s program director and planner for the enrichment Summer Program 2016 I am greatly satisfied with the achievement that happened this summer. I like to give you an update on what was a successful and amazing summer program.

The commencement of Restore’s enrichment and recreational summer program began on June 27th, two partners joined us: Elizabeth-Port Presbyterian Center and The Institute of Music for Children. We had 55 children enrolled including 8 high scholars who were our junior staff along with our committed adult staff.

We used the Restore van in addition to the E-Port bus to transport all participants and staff to the field trips. Our schedule was divided into three age groups, where kids alternated classes between Reading, Math games, Arts & Crafts, Physical Activities, Team building activities, Ice-breakers, Board games, Educational bingo, and Group projects. There were two other classes as well, our SAT preparation, for high school students, and Multimedia – Video class, for students ages 10- 12 years old.
